Sugarbirds and proteas are an expression of the terroir of the Cape Floral Kingdom (CFK). Similarly, Cape Wines are an expression of the diverse terroir of the CFK. The mere existence of the sugarbirds and the many species of proteas are an indicator of the health of the CFK and its ability to co-exist with the South African wine industry.
