The Environmental Education Association of Southern Africa (EEASA) was established at an international conference held at Treverton College, South Africa in 1982. Since then the Association has grown steadily and now has almost 400 paid-up members including teachers, conservation officials, community and development workers, resource developers and researchers from the SADC region and overseas.

EEASA Publications

Journal

Paid-up members will receive one copy of the accredited *Southern African Journal of Environmental Education* (SAJEE) annually. The SAJEE is a forum for the publication of research papers, book reviews, comments and critiques of an academic nature. Members and non-members can contribute to the journal.

Bulletin

Paid-up members also receive two issues of the *Environmental Education Bulletin* per year. The Bulletin includes articles, news snippets, regular updates, letters, reviews of new resources and other creative contributions. Members are encouraged to contribute to the Bulletin in a language of their choice.

Monograph

The EEASA monographs are occasional publications that deal with specific topics. To date four monographs have been produced, on *Evaluation in Environmental Education*, *Projects in Water Quality Monitoring*, *Indigenous Knowledge* and, recently, *Environmental Education, Ethics & Action in Southern Africa*.

WHO IS EEASA?

EEASA is its members, and members are encouraged to contribute actively to the activities of the Association. Paid-up members vote for a Council consisting of a President, a Secretary General to deal with correspondence, and a Treasurer. Council can also co-opt members as necessary. A part-time secretary handles the Association's administration and deals with membership related matters.

EEASA members in the region form conference committees who propose and are appointed to host EEASA's annual conference and workshops. The annual general business meeting of the Association takes place during the conference.

On joining, members will receive a Members' Pack containing a personalised Membership Certificate, a source book of information for environmental educators and a copy of the EEASA Constitution with further information about the manner in which the association works.
