



WWF SA/ VOYAGER COMPETITION: BLACK RHINO IMMOBILISATION EXPERIENCE

1. Entrants

- 1.1 All permanent residents of South Africa may enter.
- 1.2 Directors, members, partners, agents, consultants, tenants or employees of WWF-SA and SAA Voyager and their immediate family members are not eligible to enter this competition.
- 1.3 This competition will not be open to persons under the age of 18.

2. Term

- 2.1 The competition shall be run from 31 January 2019 to 31 March 2019.

3. The Prize

- 3.1 The Prize is a Black Rhino Immobilisation Experience which includes:
 - 3.1.1 Return Domestic flights from any major South Africa airport to Durban for two people;
 - 3.1.2 Accommodation at a luxury four star game reserve for two people; and
 - 3.1.3 Return transfers to and from the accommodation venue for two people.]
- 3.2 The following is not included:
 - 3.2.1 Transport to and from home to the airport;
 - 3.2.2 Spending money;
 - 3.2.3
- 3.3 In the event that the Prize specified in the Competition becomes unavailable for any reason, WWF-SA may substitute a Prize of like or equal value.

4. Entries

- 4.1 Entrants are entered into the competition by donating just 50 000 of their Voyager Miles to WWF-SA. Multiple entries shall be allowed.
- 4.2 WWF-SA takes no responsibility for any inability of an entrant to enter, complete, continue or conclude the competition due to equipment or technical malfunction, busy lines, inadvertent disconnection or otherwise.
- 4.3 By entering this competition the entrant accepts the full terms, conditions and rules of this competition and agrees to abide by these rules and any requirements and/or proceedings issued by WWF-SA in regard to the competition.

5. The Winner

- 5.1 The Prize will be awarded to the first entrant drawn at random (witnessed by an independent auditor), by **WWF South Africa** and the Winner will be notified by WWF-SA via email within one month of the Prize draw. If the email address provided by the entrant is not valid, he/she will forfeit the Prize, and another winner will be selected
- 5.2 The results of the competition will be verified by an independent auditor selected by WWF-SA.
- 5.3 The Winner accepts the Prize entirely at his/her own risk and indemnifies WWF-SA in respect of any claim for any accident, injury, or property damage that may occur in connection with the Prize to the fullest extent allowed by law.
- 5.4 The Winner shall be required to be medically fit to partake in the experience. If this is not the case, WWF-SA reserves the right to award the prize to an alternative winner.
- 5.5 The Prize is exclusively for the Winner (subject to paragraph **Error! Reference source not found.**) and is neither transferable nor exchangeable for cash or another Prize, and must be accepted by the Winner within **one month** of winning the Prize or he/she will forfeit the Prize.
- 5.6 The Winner may be requested to be photographed and interviewed by the promoters and have his/her name published in promoter correspondence.
- 5.7 Where a diligent attempt to contact the Winner fails or the winner elects not to take the Prize or is unable to take the Prize for whatever reason WWF-SA reserves the right to either select another Winner or not award a Prize at all, in its sole discretion.
- 5.8 If, after successful notification, the Prize is not collected within one month of being announced it will be regarded as forfeit.

6. The Promoter

- 6.1 WWF-SA reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of an entry and to refuse the entry of any person who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these terms and conditions or who tampers with any process in redeeming the Prize.
